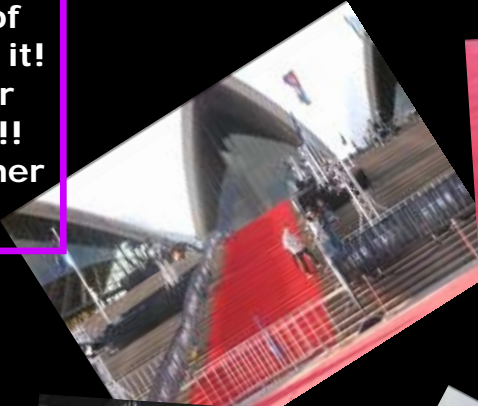

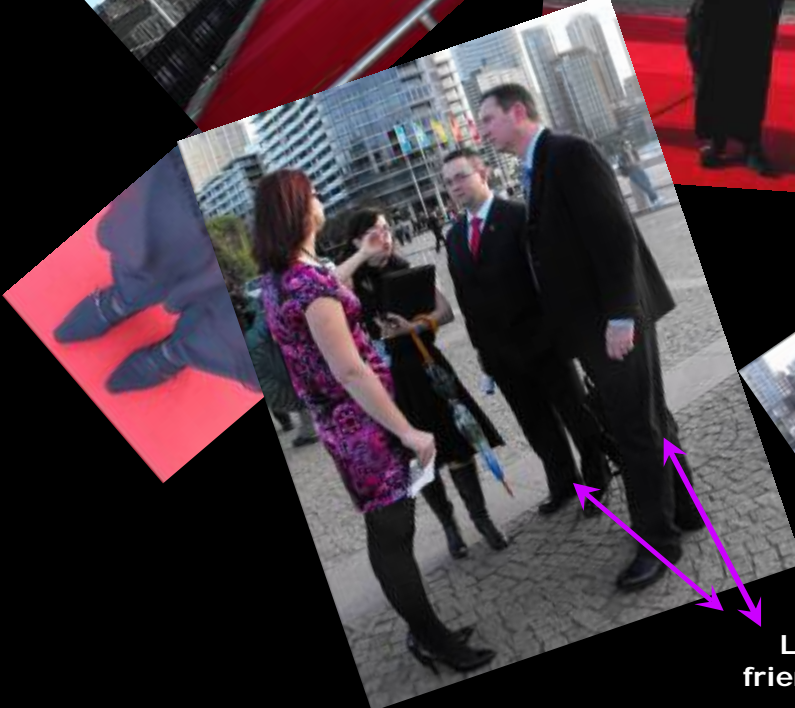
We got a Golden Ticket.

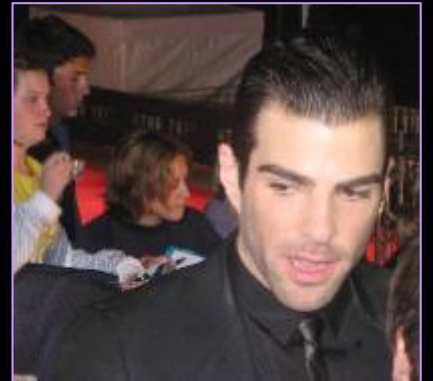

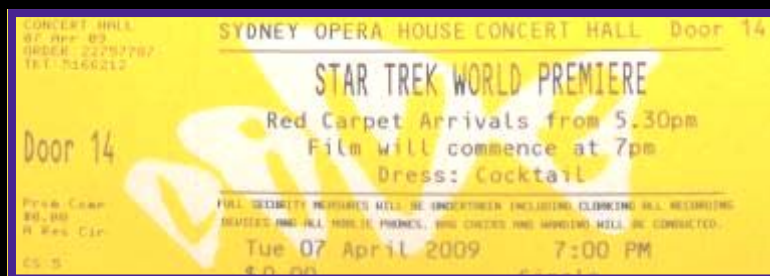
